#### Syllabus of LL.M. Entrance Test, 2022: -

The syllabus is divided in two parts. The total marks of LL.M. Entrance Test are 100.

**Part-I** (**Objective**) of syllabus consists of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ). Total marks: 60 (each question carry one mark.).

**Part –II (Subjective)** of the syllabus is based on Analytical/ Subjective and descriptive Questions. Each Question consists of 10 marks. The question to be answered in around 1000 words each. Total marks: 40
